

In response to the Bus Connects Blanchardstown to City Centre Bus Corridor Scheme NTA response.

It is deeply disappointing that ABP has decided against an oral hearing for this major project that will impact the lives of Dubliners for many years to come.

Whilst we agree that change has to happen and that to do nothing is not an option, the responses from the NTA to legitimate concerns are unsatisfactory. The NTA is simply reiterating its analysis and projections. The categorisation of the impact of increased vehicular traffic on roads, streets and junctions as low, moderate or high risk seem derisory and certainly should be questioned by ABP.

Many of the traffic flow decisions are questionable but to give just one example - the proposed change of the junction at St Peter's Church to give a left turn from NCR to Cabra Road and a right turn from Cabra Road to NCR going west is very strange and looks extremely dangerous, especially with large vehicles making that turn. Figure 2.5.14. and 15.

Phibsborough is facing at least ten years of disruption due to developments of Bus Connect's two corridors, MetroLink and other private developments, which will impact on the lives of residents and on local businesses. The least we could expect is an oral hearing at ABP. It is deeply disrespectful to Dubliners not to give us a voice.

There is no mention in the document about park and rides. Park and Rides should be an integral part of the planning and be introduced at an early stage - to encourage road users travelling through Phibsborough on two national routes to leave their cars in a safe, secure car park. (As is done in many cities in the Uk). This should be done at an early stage to reduce the impact of increased traffic volume, even before the full implementation of the scheme.
