

Thank you for your recent letter, and also for your responses to the many previous submissions regarding the above.

I just wish to reiterate, please, the already intolerable high volume of noise on the R148 (formerly M4 roadway).

As a duty of care, is there a step in the process by any responsible body involved to declare what is the exact measurement of noise? Is there an expert involved who can declare the exact noise level (however this is measured in units) and whether this is safe? For example, please reference ongoing concerns at North Dublin and the airport.

The above proposal may not add significantly to an already excessive noise level, but would certainly compound the situation due to an extra "layer" of volume of activity.
