I would like to submit an objection regarding your comment there is no legal agreement regarding the lay-by and entrance to my yard (rear of 1 St Fintans Terrace Palmerstown Dublin 20) I have a legal agreement with South Dublin county council regarding the lay-by.

It was constructed for myself by south Dublin county council after much legal argument.

It was agreed following a meeting with SDCC and Arup Consultants for entry in and out of my yard for commercial vehicles with trailers, it was agreed we drive into the yard and reverse into the lay by for exit and into the flow of traffic.

This arrangement was put in place many years ago when the junction was re opened, it is the only way we can get commercial vehicles in and out of our yard, fullstop.

The business has been in existence on the site since 1959.
