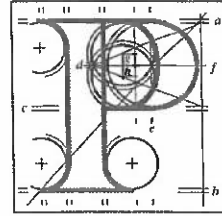

I wish to make submissions with regard to proposals for "Bus Connect". It is going to cause immense damage and upset to this neighbourhood and for what purpose, to save 5 minutes travel time, put more and more cars on the road with mess up & down some roads and traffic jams everywhere. It will cause more pollution as people will be sitting in cars etc not able to move. As it is this road can barely cope at times, there is barely enough room to go past if a bus and delivery truck are trying to pass. I have two cars badly damaged by passing traffic, one actually written off. We need a car to get to hospital and doctor appointments, we both being in our late 70's.
