



The current plans for Templeogue/Rathfarnham Bus Corridor will cause huge difficulties for our community (Rathgar Village and surrounding areas). The proposed bus corridor will cut through Rathgar and will have significantly negative impacts for Rathgar Village and surrounding roads.

Of particular concern is the greatly increased levels of traffic on Highfield Road by virtue of Rathgar Road becoming one-way towards the city centre. This change along with the proposal to allow a right turn from Rathmines Road Upper to Highfield Road will ensure that Highfield Road will become the main route for motor vehicle traffic out of town in the direction of the corridor.

Highfield Road cannot sustain that level of traffic. As it is currently, at various times of the day there is significant traffic congestion on this road leading up to Rathgar Village. The congestion will be escalated to unsustainable levels due to the increased traffic volume and proposal to allow right turns onto Highfield Road.

Add to this the intended introduction of a new Orbital Bus route on Highfield Road. This will most certainly not only amplify the traffic problems, it will also make the road unsafe for road users and pedestrians.

	resident I strongly object to. It will lead to increased noise pollution and		
	increased emissions greatly reducing the air quality. Gardens along the		
	route will be lost. All for very tiny gains if any on commute times.
