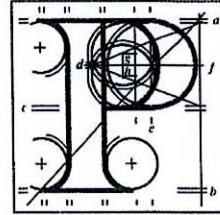


Please note that the proposed road development shall not be carried out unless the Board has approved it or approved it with modifications.

re: Application 316272 Templeogue/Rathfarnham to City Centre

Comments on proposed changes which will affect the residents of Terenure Road West and adjoining roads and developments.

The undersigned are residents of Terenure Road West. Terenure Road West (TRW) stretches from the end of Templeogue Road to the KCR. There are 140 houses on the road, a large proportion of which would have one or two cars. There is also a large school. Pavements are very narrow despite high usage. On the left hand side from Terenure Village are Greenlea Road, Parkmore Drive, Lavarna Grove and a small cul de sac called Glenavy. On the right side are Hannaville Park, Terenure Park, Hazelbrook Road and 6 or 7 Developments of houses and apartments. All these Developments have parking spaces, the largest and more recent one, Terenure Gate, having 93 spaces. Already, TRW has a large usage of cars from its own vicinity.

At present, a certain amount of traffic coming from the Walkinstown direction uses TRW either to get into the city or to travel further east. Up to now, a relatively high level of congestion occurs on it though mainly, but not always, during the morning rush hour and which can mean that commuters can suffer up to a twenty minute delay before arriving in Terenure Village. During the day there is a certain amount of congestion particularly during the school entry and exit hours due to the Presentation Schools on it.

We are alarmed to hear that it is Bus Connects' proposal to use bus gates to direct a further amount of traffic on to TRW from three areas. These are Tallaght/Templeogue direction, Wainsfort Road and Kimmage Road West (traffic is also fed on to that road from Whitehall Road and the Walkinstown Roundabout). Some of the Tallaght/Templeogue traffic will be directed on to Fortfield Road where it can access TRW via Greenlea Road, Parkmore Drive and Lavarna provided it can do a u-turn and approach these aforementioned roads on the left hand side because they link Fortfield Road with TRW.

It goes without saying that residents on TRW and its adjoining roads are apprehensive that our road is going to suffer ongoing congestion throughout the day, as well as the usual congestion at peak time and school hours. In fact, we envisage that having constant traffic on our road it will become more or less a car park with residents trapped in their homes at times when they want to use their cars.

We would ask you, Bord Pleanála, to consider the following points made by us before making final decisions and permitting any bus gates :

- given that a percentage of inhabitants in this general area are of a certain age, they need to use their cars for medical and hospital appointments. A congested road will add stress and strain to their lives as they cannot be sure that they will be allowed on to the road in the event of long delays and angry motorists.
- Having cars stalled on the road for long periods of time will be injurious to lung health and highly damaging to our environment generally.
- Having more buses in the general area will not be of any use to householders who need to go to shops for their main heavy shopping once or twice a week or to recycling centres or visiting friends.
- We have some disquiet, given the level of congestion envisaged, that problems could arise with regard to the timely arrival of emergency vehicles such as ambulances and fire trucks.
- The rights of people who pay tax on their cars to have reasonable access to public roads at all times.

While we in the TRW area are not immediately affected, we are horrified at Bus Connects' decision to cut down all the trees on both sides of Terenure Road East and appropriate parts of the gardens of the residents to facilitate a bus lane. This is very environmentally destructive in a number of ways, including the visual aspect of Terenure village.
