

Dear Sir/Madam,

The NTA has applied to An Bord Pleanála for approval for a proposed road development consisting of the BusConnets Corridor for Templeogue/Rathfarnham to the city centre. This proposed bus coridor would cut through Rathgar and has very significant negative impacts for Rathgar Village and all of the surrounding roads and indeed many other urban villages and roads in South West Dublin The claimed gains to the overall speed of buses are too small to justify the burden being placed on Rathgar and the surrounding area.

I believe heritage, trees and wildlife are threatened across Dublin.

My key concerns for the rathgar area include the increased emissions, impact on environment including noise and loss of trees. Road-widening, which threatens the architectural layout of our streets and will require the felling of mature trees. Residents on many of our smaller streets will suffer as a result of increased traffic flows and parking issues. The knock on effects will increased traffic, increased emissions include due to congestion, one way systems and parking issues. What the NTA has refused to do , is to trial proposed traffic I feel that the current plans overburden Rathgar village and surrounding roads with an increase of bus freaquency which will be detrimental to the liveability of our village and area. The routing of all buses from Templeogue/Tallaght and Rathfarham through Rathgar Village disproportionate burden on Rathgar and Rathmines. These bus routes could have easily been separated with a bus servgice interconnection in Terenure Village and along Terenure Road services separate bus East (towards Rathgar), and, alternatively, along Terenure Road North and Harolds Cross Road. There is 400 new apartments in Harold's Cross and there seems to be a decrease in buses travelling through Harold Cross and into Dublin City. Forcing all buses through Rathgar has the direct impact of overwhelming Rathgar Village and community. The route had previously been designated as a cycle but that too has been reversed by the Bus Connects proposals. Where as

there will be an inadequate public transport serviec for Harolds Cross  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{Road}}$  .
