

Re - Rathmines Bus Gate

Dear Bord Pleanala,

I write to object to the proposal to impose a Bus Gate on Rathmines Road to the Canal.

The basic prohibition of vehicle access is an uncompromised elimination of resident and users established right of access and passage. Such an attack on existing rights can hardly be justified on public policy grounds.

In practical terms this proposal is an expropriation of the utility of properties on the route. Those financially affected should have their properties purchased at full value plus disruption costs. Maybe more seriously bodies such as Rathmines Catholic Church now face an assault on their ability to operate – closure/hinderance of the church would be an unforgiveable assault on the social fabric of Rathmines.

An obvious consequence of the closure of the road to ordinary vehicles is their diversion to unsuitable adjacent roads.

I suggest that the proposal be modified to allow combined public and private use of the road or even designing the road to have an alternating in/out of town lane for use by buses depending on the rush hour.

Compromise should be considered in advance of the long term provision of new capacity by way of an underground route to Rathmines Rathgar Terenure and beyond.
