



Bus Connects proposes to make Rathgar Road a one way into town. The impact of this on the residents of the Rathgar area is that the traffic out of town will now be redirected up Upper Rathmines Road onto Highfield Road. A study has indicated that this could be +9,000 cars daily up Highfield Road, of which +500 are lorries. Highfield Road is approximately half the width of Rathgar Road, 50% shorter, and will become a complete gridlock. How will people be able to access their homes? What about the noise pollution? What about the safety of the cyclists as the road is too narrow to put in a cycle lane? This proposal is going to destroy the nature of such a historic, and cycle friendly, road, let alone be chaotic from a traffic point of view.

Secondly Bus Connects recommends reducing the garden sizes along Terenure Road, from Rathgar into Terenure. These gardens have some incredibly old trees that are habituating protected species, surely this is environmentally tragic.

Thirdly, the proposed increase in buses from Templeogue to the City Centre is minimal, around 8 a day. By the time the buses reach Rathgar there will be no room for passengers, hence people will get in their cars. Bus Connects does not serve Rathgar community as it stands. Has any thought been given to a light rail service?


