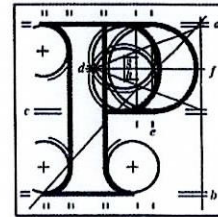

TEMPLEOGUE / RATHFARNHAM Bus Gate Proposal

OBJECTION

THIS LETTER IS A STRONG OBJECTION TO THE ABOVE. WHAT IS PROPOSED IS:-

(1) MADNESS AND SOCIALLY DIVISIVE; THIS IS DANGEROUS TO SCHOOL CHILDREN AT St. MARK'S R.C. SCHOOL IN RATHFINES - THIS PROPOSAL WILL MAKE IT EXTREMELY DANGEROUS FOR CHILDREN TO ARRIVE AND DEPART SAFELY TO THIS INSTITUTION AND HAZARDOUS TO COLLECT SUCH CHILDREN.

(2) THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH OF MARY IMMACULATE REFUGE OF SINNERS WILL SUFFER SIGNIFICANT ADVERSE ATTENDANCE PROBLEMS - FOR THOSE OF US WHO ATTEND THIS MAGNIFICENT PLACE OF WORSHIP. CATHOLICS STILL HAVE RIGHTS IN WHAT IS NOW TERMED "MODERN IRELAND". A RETURN TO PENAL LAWS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

(3) BUSINESS AND ITS ² EMPLOYEES PROVIDE THE STATE WITH TAX REVENUE TO FUND ITS ACTIVITIES AND SERVICES. THIS PROPOSED SCHEME WILL BE DETRIMENTAL TO PRIVATE ENTERPRISE AND ITS EMPLOYEES — WITH RESULTANT FAILURE OF BUSINESSES AND EMPLOYMENT. IT IS A PITY WE CANNOT BANKRUPT THE NATIONAL TRANSPORT AUTHORITY WHICH IS OVERTLY ARROGANT.

(4) TO THOSE OF US WHO HAVE RELATIONS ON THE NORTHSIDE OF DUBLIN VISITING WILL BECOME TIME CONSUMING AND REQUIRE MULTI BUS CHANGES. PLUS HAVING TO RETURN IMMEDIATELY UPON ARRIVAL!! HAVING A CAR IS NOT AN OFFENCE AND TAKING UP RESIDENCE IN BUSES IS NOT A LIFESTYLE PUSHING VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ONTO FEWER ROADS IS IN SANITY.

(5) THIS BUS GATE NONSENSE IS SOLVING A PROBLEM WHICH DOES NOT EXIST. TRAFFIC FLOW CURRENTLY WORKS WELL ALONG THE PROPOSED ROUTE. THERE ARE SLOW TIMES 7.45 AM - 9 AM AND 4.30 - 6 PM MONDAY TO FRIDAY. SUCH DELAYS ARE TOLERABLE. END ANGERING SCHOOLS - CHILDREN - CHURCHES - BUSINESS - EMPLOYEES IS NOT ACCEPTABLE.

(6) THIS PROPOSED PLAN⁽³⁾ IS A FURTHER IMPOSITION ON SOCIETY SO BELOVED BY CONTROL FREAKS ELEVATED TO POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY WITHOUT A PUBLIC MANDATE. FOR PROFOUND CHANGE THE ELECTORATE SHOULD AND MUST GIVE ITS IMPRIMATUR.

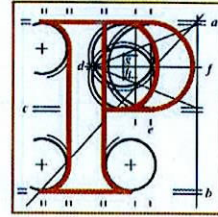
