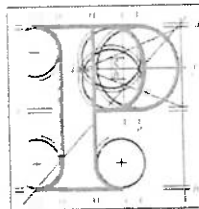


Please note that the proposed road development shall not be carried out unless the Board has approved it or approved it with modifications.

Hi,

Please find attached Submission plus Postal Order in the amount of €50 from myself and neighbours of Derravaragh Road and Corrib Road.

We are objecting to the plans for a set of bollards at junction of Derravaragh and Corrib which will block easy road access to Terenure village.

This will mean only a single point of access to our area and likely bottlenecks at this point (on Corrib Road) as well as increased traffic along the already congested Kimmage Road.

The consultation document states that the bollard is being erected in order to prevent traffic passing through the area.

However this could be achieved by introducing turning restrictions at certain peak times of the day on Terenure Rd W as has been done on other nearby roads (Aideen Ave and Terenure Pk).

Turning restrictions would restrict traffic cutting through the area at peak times while retaining residents' access to Terenure village and preventing bottlenecks at Corrib Rd.

There is already a set of bollards about 100 meters away from junction of Derravaragh/Corrib at Aideen and Derravaragh, they are unsightly and ugly and we feel it is unfair if you go ahead with a second set.

Our other suggestion is if bollards do go up at Derravaragh/Corrib that they erect the big permanent Planter Boxes and this is repeated at the Derravaragh/Aideen junction.

(Remove the unsightly existing ones).

Lots of the Residents have commented that the existing Bus Service in our area is very good and all this change is unnecessary.
