

I refer to the above application by National Transport Authority and wish to make observations on the proposals:

I live in Hazel Park a small <u>Cul</u> de Sac a few yards north of site of one of the proposed Bus Gates at Ravensdale Park.

I am a regular bus user and also use a car My observations relate to the Bus Gate and bus commuting:

Despite being encouraged to travel on public transport I find that the changes in most cases involve switching buses even for short trips

The number 17 bus which took us directly to Shopping Centres in Nutgrove Dundrum and also Blackrock and schools including UCD has been taken out of service.

Eg; My elderly neighbour who used the 17 bus to shop weekly in <u>Nutgrove</u> will now have to get 2 buses including crossing a busy road junction to change bus.

I thought I could offer her a lift but this isn't a great option if we are trying to limit emissions nor does it allow her to live an independent life AND when I grapple with the future plans for Bus Gates, rerouting of traffic etc., I cannot figure out if I can get to <u>Nutgrove</u> by car unless I go on a very long detour How can this be an improvement in service? How can this be green.

Really bad communication about these changes leaves people confused/worried/wondering what sort of life we will have and who is making these decisions and showing no concern for what people actually need from public transport. The 16 bus which took us directly to Dublin Airport is also being taken out of service we will now have to get 2 buses including in many cases having to haul large heavy bags across busy road junctions.

There is a new 74 Radial bus which winds its way through narrow roads and streets and ends it's long route in Dundrum it is by no means a replacement for the direct 17 bus.8

Notes

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The bus connects appears to me to be a system suited to a metro system where you are not overly concerned if you are going around a longer route because it is fast and reliable and regular. A bus system does not work in the same way.

We were promised a metro system some years ago.

In relation to the Ravensdale Bus Gate it is a major inconvenience to residents living close to the Gate and leaves them very disadvantaged. It seems that no consideration was given to residents living between the 2 bus gates on F Spine and with another very close to our F Spine.

We had no correspondence or flyers from NTA at any stage on the matter.

More than 90% of my driving is through the KCR crossroads which is 0.4Klm from my house I now have to travel 2.8Klms before I arrive at KCR this is through narrow busy residential roads while Bus Gate is operating. I feel almost imprisoned in my house as there is no other access off Lr Kimmage Rd South other exits are being closed off to traffic.

My driving is mostly when I have to travel to Wicklow at least twice per week. It is also necessary to use car for heavier shopping and for larger goods.

There is major lack of any information regarding our bin collections and deliveries to the 2 supermarkets and pub and Pharmacy Post collection etc,. situated outside our Cul de Sac

I trust consideration will be given to the opinions of the end users in coming to your decision.
