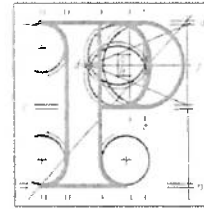

My observation is that the bus gates are closed, even when buses are not running - on Sunday mornings. There does not seem to be any flexibility on lifting the gates so we can move from our homes.


The position of the bus gates mean that our road will be used as a rat run - even worse than it is now.
