



In relation to the N11 Bus Connects proposal.

With removal of slip roads south bound up Johnstown Road, south bound at Clonkeen road and Foxrock Church heading down Kill Lane. It will impact and add further congestion to the N11. It will enforce a bypass of Deansgrange as a consequence. The slip road at Newtownpark Avenue will remain acting as an alternative route to facilitate bypassing Deansgrange. It has been quoted that 75% of the traffic in Deansgrange is through traffic but a lot of businesses located in Deansgrange are built around this through traffic and require it to stay in business. It could have a detrimental negative effect on the small businesses, economy and community in Deansgrange.
