

Ref: 317742 Bray Bus Connects

Please find below my observations on the proposed Bray Bus Connects scheme.

I broadly welcome the proposal for this scheme to encourage and enhance use of public transport, as well as providing safer cycling and pedestrian infrastructure.

I have concerns about the proposed works at Patrician Villas (Sheet 20). Given the proximity of the bus stop to Stillorgan Park Road and the estate's entrance, I question the rationale for and benefit of the access ramp from the N11 into Patrician Villas. I believe loss of green space, play area and the residents' enjoyment of their neighbourhood outweigh the potential gain.

Additionally, I believe the existing nature-based screening from the road delivers a reasonably effective visual and noise barrier. The planting and green space deliver vital space for biodiversity in the area. The space is widely used by children playing, which would not be possible if the ramp is constructed.

If the ramp has to be installed, I ask you to reconsider the location, to minimise the loss of green space, biodiversity and space for play.

This project is also an opportunity to upgrade the underpass, thus improving access for people with disabilities, people with mobility issues, as well pedestrians and cyclists.
