

A Chara,

I wish to state my profound objection to the Bus Connects plan to eliminate a large number of parking spaces in front of commercial and retail properties in the Castle Street area of Bray Co. Wicklow.

This is being proposed, allegedly, to improve the flow of buses into Bray. However, it will do no such thing, as the buses will be halted a short distance later at the Fran O' Toole Bridge. There will be no meaningful improvement in journey times but it will cause an enormous amount of disruption of trade and economic activity in the businesses most affected by the loss of crucial parking spaces.

The Members of Wicklow County Council unanimously agreed at its monthly meeting on October 2nd last, to object to this part of the Bus Connects proposal and it was agreed that this objection would be forwarded to An Bord Pleanála as part of the public consultation process.

I urge the Board to refuse permission for this element of the Bus Connects Scheme.
