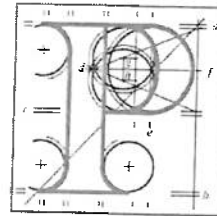

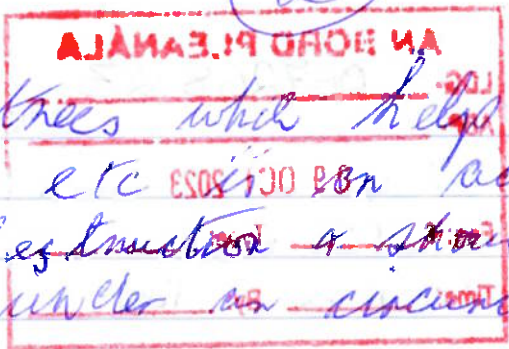
Dear Sir / Madam.

I wish to object to the above on the following grounds.

- Our access to Seaview Park would be severely impacted by having a four lane carriageway at the top of the entrance to our estate.
- It is extremely difficult at present to ~~to~~ exit to the right going toward the city and it would mean instead of crossing two lanes it would now have to cross four lanes.
- The green hump at present between Seaview Park and the motorway was put there as a noise abatement measure and even with this there is substantial motorway noise which impacts on our property. If ~~5~~ 5 metres of trees are to be felled the noise would be unbearable.
- It would be impossible to cross a four lane roadway to catch a bus at our bus stop.
- The felling of such a large number of
