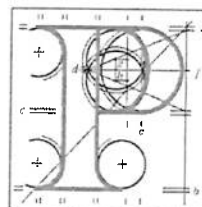

**Re: Bray to City Centre Core Bus Corridor Scheme - Number on map deposited at NTA
1001(29).2e - Green verge along Stillorgan road adjoining South Park Dublin 18.**

To whom it may concern,

Regarding the above-mentioned extract from the schedule of work, we would like to raise an objection on the basis that the opening of the proposed laneway into South Park is an entirely unnecessary undertaking.

There already exists a laneway, providing similar access from the existing bus stop, located on the Map with a designation 1001(28).1e.

This laneway, connecting the Stillorgan Road to Beech Park is a mere 10 metres beyond the proposed new lane. This laneway already has a modern concrete path and suitable access to the Beech Park / South Park estates. Its existence surely renders the proposed works utterly redundant and as such, unnecessary.

With no material benefit to the proposed works, this work must represent a complete waste of money with no additional benefit to the residents of either Beech Park or South Park, nor providing any greater access beyond that which already exists.
