

Route - Bus Connects - Bray to City Centre

The proposal by National Transport Authority to make serious changes to various aspects of our village Shankill are wholly unacceptable and therefore I would like to appeal them. I am opposed to any trees being cut down, the elimination of the roundabout in front of the church, the closing off of the entrance to Corbawn Lane and the introduction of a right hand turn at Beechfield Road.

We are fortunate in Shankill in that we have a very good public transport service and the proposals by NTA will bring about an insignificant improvement to the time of the bus journey. NTA's own records state that the saving for the whole journey will be between 5.9 and 7.3minutes at a cost of 2 billion. The introduction of paying for your ticket at the bus stop as opposed to on the bus, will achieve a bigger time saving.

A sensible proposal was made to eliminate the footpaths on the bridge and replace them with a raised walkway on the inside of the bridge wall – on both sides.

Since NTA started this plan, Wicklow CoCo have now got a plan to put a bus corridor out on the N11 – it seems to be a duplication of facilities. An opportunity was lost where a house with significant lane i.e St Annes, behind the chuch could have been CPO'd and provide for a traffic circus between the Dublin Road and the Shanganagh Road.
