

Dear Sirs,

I have only recently become aware of the intention to eliminate all slip roads off the N 11 as part of the Bray Bud Connects plan.

In my opinion this will result in major traffic congestion along the N11 as at each junction, it will only be possible to access or depart the N11 one vehicle at a time. There has to be a solution that can deliver the bulk of the benefits of Bus Connects without having such a drastic effect on access and egress for the N11.

Furthermore I fully appreciate that this is part of the strategy to reduce car usage on the roads but, as is the case with many such proposals, there seems to be very little account taken of the needs of some of our increasing number of senior citizens for whom the concept of cycling, walking or taking the bus is simply not possible due to personal mobility issues.
