

- Revised public notices reflecting the updated remedial Environmental Impact Assessment Report.

The Environmental Impact Assessment Report should comply with all of the provisions of article 112 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2000-2023, in particular your attention is drawn to Article 112(1)(a) which states "not more than 2 weeks before submitting the EIAR, publish notice of the intention to submit the EIAR in at least one approved newspaper". Additionally, Article 112(5)(d) states that the Environmental Impact Assessment Report is "sent to the EIA portal in electronic form" and a copy of the confirmation notice is submitted to the Board.

Furthermore, you are required to submit 6 hard copies and 1 electronic copy of the remedial Environmental Impact Assessment Report to the Board. A copy of the revised public notices are to be submitted to the Board.
