2. Adequate precaution shall be taken to ensure that existing road drainage in the area is not impeded by the proposed development.
3. The septic tank shall be so located and constructed to prevent any polluted matter emanating from it entering any stream, well or watercourse serving public use.
4. Landscaping shall be carried out as per agreement subject to the approval of the Planning Authority.
