




Fencing Type "C" - Steel Posts (80mm diameter), spacing approx. 4m - 5m, 9 No. wires fixed between posts with no electric charge. Posts either set in concrete or driven into ground. Posts no more than 1.8m above ground.


Site Outline shown by dashed line-See drawings 03 01-2 &3. Fencing between points X" and Y", type D fencing between 1.4m and 1.6 m high.

Fencing type D . General timber posts 100mm to 150 mm diameter, spacing at circa 4m to 5m centres. 6 No or 7 No wires fixed between posts with electric charge as catttle proofing. Posts either set in concrete or driven into ground. Posts vary in height, between 1.4m and 1.6 m over surrounding ground level. 1:50.




Fencing type E. Timber posts 100mm to 150 mm diameter, spacing at circa 4m to 5m centres. 9 No wires fixed between posts with no electric charge. Posts either set in concrete or driven into ground. Posts no more than 1.8 m height above surrounding ground level. 1:50.

Location of fencing for which leave to apply for Substitute Consent is sought indicated by red line thus:

FENCING AT POINT "T"



Fencing at Point "T" - 2 No. Steel Posts (80mm diameter) & 2 No. Timber posts (100 - 150mm diameter), spacing approx. 2m - 3m, 9 No. wires fixed between posts with no electric charge, forest green steel mesh on steel post section. Posts either set in concrete or driven into ground. Posts no more than 1.8m above ground.
