- 80 kph Mandatory Speed limit applies to this carriageway
- Sightlines cannot be achieved and are restricted to minimal distances by neighbouring property boundaries and the narrow vergeless nature of the laneway
- Average Carriageway width <3.0m

Tipperary County Council shall determine whether the appropriate speed and sight distance has been used for each planning application.
