

APPLICATION TO AN BORD PLEANÁLA FOR SUBSTITUTE CONSENT

SITE NOTICE

I, Mark Rochford, intend to apply for substitute consent for development at this site  
**Forest Lower, Mountmellick, Co Laois.**

**The development consists of historic development comprising of 2 no Cubicle sheds, total floor area 3770m<sup>2</sup> (Cow Welfare Units), associated concrete feed passages, total area 1485m<sup>2</sup>. Slurry Lagoon, total capacity 4095m<sup>3</sup> (Sealed Effluent Storage). Silage Pit, total floor area 1180m<sup>2</sup> (Winter Feed Storage), accompanying Concrete Apron, total floor area 545m<sup>2</sup>, adjoining concrete yards, total floor area 1263m<sup>2</sup> and associated site works.**

**This application for substitute consent is accompanied by a remedial Natura Impact Statement (rNIS).**

Submissions or observations may be made on the application, to An Bord Pleanála, Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, without charge. Submissions or observations must be in writing and made within the period of 8 weeks beginning on the date of receipt of the application by An Bord Pleanála and such submissions and observations will be considered by An Bord Pleanála in making a decision on the application. An Bord Pleanála may grant the consent subject to or without conditions, or may refuse to grant it. The application for consent may be inspected, or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the offices of An Bord Pleanála, or the relevant planning authority during its public opening hours.
