On the basis of the information and plans submitted by you on the 25th March, 2019 the Planning Authority having considered the question posed, "whether the diminution of the curtilage of dwellinghouse premises for the purposes of gifting a garden to a family member for the purposes of building a dwellinghouse thereon development or is it exempted development" has declared that it does not constitute development as set out under Section 3 of the Planning and Development Act 2000.


