I am writing in respect of the above named nursing home. Depaul obtained notification from South Dublin County Council that the former nursing home was being treated as an exempted development relating to Part 4, Schedule 2 of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001.

We were notified that a Part V referral had been made to An Bord Pleanála in respect of this exemption. We are working with South Dublin County Council on the commencement date of the service which has full support from all of our statutory partners.

As we are eager to commence this badly needed service due to the demand and need as result of the current homelessness crisis, Depaul would respectfully request that this referral be treated as a priority case.
