



I refer to your letter of the 28th may.

It is Important to note that the purpose of this section 5 review is to determine,

"Whether the use of an outdoor Gantry loading Crane is, OR is not development OR is or is not exempt development.

It has nothing to do with Mr McEvoys submission which seeks the Bord to judicially determine the planning status of the facility which is in existence almost 50 years.

In practical terms the company were using a forklift to load the precast products onto trucks for delivery. It was deemed hazardous to continue loading trucks this way so the company extended the internal gantry crane out past the existing shed to safely facilitate loading of trucks.

It is important to note that this does not in any way change the output of the factory nor does it add any additional vehicular movements on the public road.

All it does is make the loading process safer and cleaner for the environment as it replaces a diesel engine with an electric apparatus.

Mr. McEvoy is well known to this Company. Since 2005 he has made all kinds of outrageous and unfounded allegations to numerous regulatory bodies such as the H.S.A., R.S.A., E.P.A., Laois Co. Council. He is very friendly with Michael & Mary Whelan who allow him to use their names and address

There are 86 pages in Mr. McEvoy's submissions, most of which I have seen in the past being re-hashed and re-dated. Having said that I will comment on some parts.

I have numerically labeled the pages in green pen for ease of reference.

Submission of objection for planning retention by Booth Concrete. Firstly, this is <u>not</u> a retention application and as such, I don't know why Michael & Mary Whelan have the right to make a submission to a Section 5 Application. Note the Section 5 application was made to determine whether a gantry crane is or is not exempt Development. The installation of this gantry crane will not add 1 vehicles to the vehicles going in or out of the plant. It was installed to replace a fork truck.

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- Placing of a footpath opposite Mr. McEvoy's house was done by Laois Co. Council. Booth Concrete provided all the Page 5 engineering design and drawings for a Part 8 which has greatly improved the safety.
- Mr. McEvoy comes to a lot of conclusions that he has no qualifications to do so. He I not an Ecologist, a Hydrologist or an Page 6 Archeologist?
- I can only assume was inserted in error by Mr. McEvoy. His notes on the top of Page 7 bemoan his lack of financial reward Page 7 for taking a legal case against us. His written note clearly shows his entire motivation is money.
- Sheridan Quinn are found guilty of wrong doing for not declaring a payment of €46,500 from their client, not relevant to Page 8/9 Our Section 5 Application but Page 7 really shows Mr. McEvoy's motivation is compensation for having to live near a quarry.
- This is an internal email referring to a 2012 planning application. Laois Co. Council confirming that a site notice was erected. Page 10 Just another example of Mr. McEvoy's Vexatious complaints to the local authority
- Page 11 Internal Laois Co. Council email, outlines the various permissions on the site, Mr. McEvoy doesn't accept that these Permissions are valid for some reason.
- Grant of permission to extend working hours. Note his hand written notes "Handed to me by Garda, Re Laois Co. Council Page12 no planning notice ever put up". On 12/09/2012, Garda came to the plant at around 7.15am stating we were not allowed 13
  - & 14 to open at 7am. I gave Garda copy of the permission which he obviously gave to Mr. McEvoy. This graphically shows how Mr. McEvoy conducts his business. Make a false allegation, without first checking The planning files which is easily obtained on line.
- This is part of a settlement agreement from 2010 that the Company agreed to abide by pending planning permission which Page 15 was granted in 2010, to retain certain activities and traffic volumes. Once granted permission the court order became Page 16 Redundant.
- Page 17 All examples of complaints and harassment from Mr. McEvoy, any real issues were resolved with LCC.

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- Page 25/26 More planning complaints about manufacturing buildings that were re-roofed and a new gantry crane installed. This complaint refers to the gantry crane that is the subject of this Referral Case Number ABP-309964-21 , 27/28
- Page 29 Photo of a tractor. Don't know the significance of this.
- Photo of a tractor, that Mr. McEvoy says came from Booth Concrete at 19.18, our authorized closing time is 20.00, and so Page 30 if this came from the plant, I don't understand the problem.
- Page 31 Two photos of mixer drums from 2003. Don't know the context except it states that Booth Concrete and Laois County Council improved the road.
- There are photos of a lorry carrying lightweight concrete flooring. Mr. McEvoy seems to suggest this is dangerous and Page 32 and unsecured load. He fails to appreciate that this product was made from lightweight concrete and is secured by the & 35 Crane compressing the load downwards.
- Page 33/34 Photo of a truck and a tractor on 15/05/21.

35/36 Don't know what the significance of this is.

Page 42-87 Unable to read the writing, but it appears to be a list of vehicles passing Mr. McEvoy's house?

As this is a public road, many of the vehicles are not related to the Company. No registration numbers noted.

Mr. McEvoy appears to have a camera on the public road which is disturbing in relation to GDPR regulations.

As is evident from the foregoing, for many years, Mr. McEvoy has done anything he could to prevent the company from carrying out its business.




I refer to the above planning application & wish to make the following submission / objection in relation to the proposed development.

I wish to object to the proposed development based on the points outlined below:

- Main objection is that the road in which Booth Concrete will be travelling on is not suitable
  for HGV vehicles as it stands there is barely room to gets past another car on this road in
  parts.
- The Road is slowly deteriorating everyday as a result of HGV vehicles currently going to and from Booth Concretes existing business at Ballymullen.
- The current traffic in and out past our property is excessive every day and at all hours by Booth Concrete and as a result we would have major concerns of anymore planning being granted as the volume of traffic will no doubt double or treble from what it currently is.
- The current HGV are flying up and down the road each day with a speed limit of 80km with no stop sign at the junction of our road.
- The HGV currently show no consideration for residents driving on this road they presume
  they have control of the road even on narrow sections they do not slow down making drivers
  pull into the ditch just to avoid an accident.
- Our personal concern is for the safety of our kids due to the speed of these HGV past our home on a daily basis specifically as we have a 15year old boy with Autism who is non-verbal and would not have the road sense to not run across the road if he were to get out of the garden. We have a gate which we lock to protect him but that is not to say anyone calling would not leave the gate unlocked and he would be gone and given the current volume and speed of Booth Concrete HGV past our property we have serious safety concerns as such we strongly object to anymore planning or retention of planning being granted to Booth Concrete for the Application

#### A Chara

I am writing in relation to the above, my reason is the Intensification that there is already 200+ Trucks passing my home from 5am in the morning till all hours at night, 7 days a week. I have a high court order which States hours Booth Concrete are allowed to operate 8am – 6pm Monday to Saturday ,with no work on a Sunday which you will see from the traffic count (ex for 2 days) that this is not the case.

This is an unauthorised development and now they are looking to retain planning on the Gantry and they already have one and had no planning for this either. This is supposed to be a Business premises not an industrial estate as it is now. Ref 95/300 it is supposed to be a sand pit only not industrial units. They also have two batching plant built and these do not have planning permission, it needs planning as it is supplying Booth Precast with Sand & Gravel.

I am very aware that Booth Concrete does not have a discharge licence and are pumping waste into rivers.

From Jan 2020 Booths have been drawn from Sean Wilson in Ballyragget inside SpC - reported to Kilkenny County Council and nothing was done by Kilkenny County Council.

I reported Hazard waste in the past to LCC and I got no reply.

None of the above have on EIS. OR EIA

I am aware of BC bursting the water supply in Days Pitt Abbeyleix on two occasions and I have reported an overturned Track Digger. IN Days No EIA EIS & No Planering

I had a high court order against BC which they do not adhere to. I took multiple cases against Booth Precast and I won all cases but as yet I have not received the 370k that I was awarded from the Solicitor. Scath

## No. 2 The Parent and Connected Development:

In spite of there being No visible site notice Laois County Council granted permission for reference 12/46 on the 8<sup>th</sup> of May 2012. I attach correspondence regarding the validation of the site notice (attached as appendix 3), it should be noted that development consent was never granted for this development.

Previous to this, Planning ref; 10/290, permission was granted on appeal by An Bord Pleanala ref: PL11.239204 on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of November 2011.

The Ballymullen site has been extended in several directions in recent years, the main ones are marked on the map in appendix 1. The consequences and implications will have to be taken into account before this can be considered to be a valid application for 20/7


Shale Quarrying (major intensification going on in last month) /NCHERRED by THERE'S
The Ballymullen development was extended to Ballymullen Farm ref UD20/11

• The quarry was then extended down the road where they removed a small plantation.

 In 2013 a scaffolding hire service started operating on and from the site without planning permission.

I attach a copy of the unauthorized development form for these unauthorized developments which I submit with this objection. (attached in appendix 2)

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The Planning authority are obliged to consider the effects of the increased traffic passing my home including the increased damage caused by placing a footpath on the opposite of the road from my home, forcing this heavy traffic closer to my home which has increased the impact and structural damage being caused to my boundary wall and to my home.

## No. 3 History of the Ballymullen site:

The parent development is best described as a concrete block and precast concrete manufacturing plant which has now been intensified to include shale quarrying.

'In brief Mr. Phil Butler sold concrete batching plant to Arastra – this is confirmed Aidan O'Connell's letter of the 15<sup>th of</sup> December 2004 to Laois County Council, which goes on to state:

'the extraction of sand and gravel is exclusively Butlers, none by Arastra, the material is not suitable for concrete manufacturing'

Mr. Phil Butler passed away in April 2005. In 2006 Mrs. Kay Butler sold a disused Quarry with a license to Booth Concrete.

Since 2001- Current date all the majority of truck movements relate to Booth Ready-mix, Precast and Blocks, which require input of raw materials into Ballymullen since there is not suitable on site.

Booth Concrete started the Precast Concrete business in 1994 in Bland's.

Kwik Precast started approx.4 years ago manufacturing concrete columns and there is another company manufacturing Breton slabs and concrete in 2018.

In 1994 Arastra Construction (Booth Concrete) moved to Bland's of Blandsfort.

Since 2001 Booth Concrete started in Ballymullen, Abbeyleix, and drew all their material from Bland's and other Quarries UD.

Booths supply all concrete related material to all companies on site, all coming from unauthorized developments. Approx. 1000 tonne per day going onto Ballymullen site for processing.

I have a high court order which is being ignored by Booth Concrete.

## No. 4 Planning History of the sand and gravel abstraction:

The first application for is dated 15<sup>th</sup> May 1995 was on an area of 4.515 HA. Condition no.26 was for a plan to reinstate the lands. Mr. Phil Butler obtained planning permission under planning register reference 95/300 on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of September 1996 which granted planning permission for the development of land namely 'to **retain** concrete plant, extraction of sand and grand and washing facility at Ballymullen House, Ballymullen, Abbeyleix subject to 31 conditions.



## Conclusion 1. No assessment of the Impact on the SAC site code 2126:

No assessment in compliance with Article 3 of the EIA directive has ever been carried out for this development (see case C-50/09). Retention permission is not available for developments that have commenced before an application for development consent has been made and approved C-215/06.

#### Conclusion 2. No Enforcement:

It has always been the position of the planning authorities in respect of this site that it should be reconstituted once quarrying had ceased but conditions 1,2,3,5,15 and 26 of 95/300 and condition no.11 of register reference 98/780 are not being complied with and the Planning authority are not enforcing them.

## No. 5 Location of the Ballymullen site:

The development site is Adjacent to Abbeyleix Bog otherwise known as Killamuck Bog, covering an area of 109 HA and which contains three Annex 1 habitats but has not been officially designated. (Grid reference 2433700 / 182600) \*. The site is drained by a natural drain between the bog to the west and a man-made drain to the east both of which are connected to the River Nore site code 216.

I have also enclosed some photographs which have dates of out of hour working and also of some dangerous loads. You have to appreciate that there are families living along this stretch of road and the number of trucks going in and out of Booth Concrete is massive and with dangerous loads and narrow roads it's an accident waiting to happen.







(a) do stand censured,



AN Abbeyleix man who took photographs of the comings and goings at a local concrete plant to ensure the company was in compliance with High Court orders had a public order case dismissed against him when he appeared at Portlaoise District Court last Thursday.

Tom McEvoy (54) with an address at Ballymullen, Abbeyleix contested that on 16 April 2010 at Ballymullen, Abbeyleix he engaged in threatening, abusive and insulting behaviour.

Taking the stand, Michael Carroll said in his sworn evidence that he worked as a fitter with Booth Concrete at Ballymullen for the past

11 years.

He said that at about 7.55am that morning, while waiting for the gates of the plant to open, "a man with a big camera took photos of me. I knew him as Tom McEvoy. I don't like anyone taking photos of me. He said nothing to me. I knew him from just passing down the road. He's always looking at you."

Mr Carroll told the court that Mr McEvoy was standing by his own car pointing the camera towards him. He stated; "I was wondering why he was taking photos. What his problem was? He does be hiding in the ditches across the road in the field taking photos

as well."

Junior counsel for Mr McEvoy, Julie Gillane, instructed by solicitor Marie McGee from Sheridan/Quinn solicitors, said that Mr Carroll was a very loyal employee to the company and that his employer was in court.

She asked Mr Carroll if he was aware that a High Court order had been made limiting the number of trucks using the concrete facility on a daily basis. She asked him since the order was imposed had production decreased or his wages decreased. Mr Carroll agreed there had been a decrease in production and a decrease in his income.







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# Clean-up of site containi hazardous asbestos begi

THE clean-up of the old Midland Dairies site on the Mountrath Road in Portlaoise containing hazardous asbestos began on Monday.

Two weeks ago, the Loois Nationalist revealed that the owners of the site, Pat, Peter and John Booth, trading as Booth Partnership, had been served with notice from Laois Co Council to clean up their site or face up to ten years in jail or/ and a maximum fine of £15 million.

Two of the company's directors and a specialist company from Kildare, Environmental Waste Technologies Limited, which deals with hazardous waste including asbestos, were on site on Monday. A number of workers wore protective clothing, hard hats and breathing masks during the clean-up operation.

The man who claimed he had been raising the issue of asbestos on the site for over seven years with the relevant authorities and local councillors, but had got very little response to his BY JOE BARRETT

concerns, Tom McEvoy, was also on hand surveying the clean-up work.

Mr McEvoy had described the site as a "ticking time bomb" with "lethal asbestos mixed in with rubble."

The company said it had previously cleaned up the site and had disposed of low grade asbestos sheeting that had been on it. They said they had inspected the site recently with representatives from an accredited asbestos waste disposal company and found "material was planted on site by someone."


The company asserted "there is no health hazard arising from this site," and gave an undertaking that the works would be carried out by the end of this month in accordance with Laois Co Council's instructions.
