HABITAT CONDITION ASSESSMENT FOR MARSH FRITILLARY

Habitat condition monitoring for the Marsh Fritillary involves fixed point habitat recording on a structured walk across a site, from which an assessment can be made. A separate survey and assessment should be completed for each sub-site.

METHOD

- Establish a W shape (zigzag) route that will cross thoroughly and evenly the whole site/sub-site.
- Decide stopping distances along this route where recordings of habitat condition will be made e.g. every 10 or 20 paces. Aim to have at least 20 stopping points for a small site (<1 ha) more than 40 stopping points for a medium-sized site (1-5 ha) and more than 50 stopping points for a large site (>5 ha).
- Follow your route and at each stopping point measure (in cm) the vegetation height at the point you stop (measure to the top of the leaves i.e. ignore the flowers of grasses and plants). Then, using an imaginary box with sides of 1 m in front of you, record the presence of Devil's-bit Scabious in one of these abundance categories (A = 1-2 plants, B = 3-9 plants, C = 10+ plants, D = No plants). Using the same area, record (mark with an 'X') the presence or absence of these three habitat attributes: structured vegetation, low (<25 cm tall) invading scrub with a cover of >10% and stock grazing signs (e.g. tracks, poach marks, dung).
- At the end of the assessment, then provide an estimate the cover (%) of tall (>0.5 m) scrub for the whole site/sub-site.






Figure 3: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:25,000




Figure 4: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:10,000






Figure 5: EVIDENCE OF POTENTIAL UNAUTHORISED ACTIVITY 07/06/21




Figure 6: EVIDENCE OF POTENTIAL UNAUTHORISED ACTIVITY 07/06/21






Figure 3: EVIDENCE OF POTENTIAL UNAUTHORISED ACTIVITY 09/05/20




Figure 1: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:100,000




Figure 2" LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:50.000




Figure 3: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:25,000






Figure 4: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:10,000

My name is Patrick Moran. I live at Sillogue, Kilberry, Navan, Co. Meath. On the 29th of July, 2019 I applied for a determination under S5 of the Planning and Development Acts 2000 – 2018 (KAS51942) as regards Drainage of wetland habitat (Raised Bog) and mechanical disturbance, extrusion of peat and removal of turf from a site at Drakerath, Wilkinstown, Co. Meath. On the 29th August I received a letter from Meath Co. Council informing me that Meath Co. Council had failed to deal with the application within the appropriate time frame and that should I wish I could refer the matter to An Bord Pleanála.

My application concerns an area of raised bog habitat (I am principal ecologist with FERS Ltd, an environmental consultancy) occurring at Drakerath, Wilkinstown, Co. Meath. Raised bog is a wetland habitat¹. Approximately 84% of Ireland's raised bog habitat has been affected by peat extraction, having implications for both climate and biodiversity². The site in question comprises approximately 88Ha (in total including areas of cutaway) wetland of high biodiversity value (and a regionally important carbon sink) that is being drained (the drain network discharges to the River Blackwater, a component of the River Boyne and River Blackwater Special Area of Conservation) and from which peat is being extracted by persons unknown. This development and similar developments nationwide are contributing to the climate and biodiversity emergency declared by the government. The development includes drainage of a wetland habitat (total area 88 ha approximately) where in excess of 2 ha of wetland habitat is being affected (cf 1 (c) part (2) schedule 5 of the planning and development regulations (as amended) 2001). This activity is having a significant impact on the environment. Even if considered sub-threshold, the impact on the environment of the development should require at minimum EIA screening in accordance with the planning and development regulations (as amended) 2001. The discharge of drains to the River Blackwater should, at minimum, require Appropriate Assesment screening.

Given the recent declaration of a "Climate and Biodiversity Emergency", the threats of An Taoiseach that Ireland will vote against the controversial Mercosur trade agreement unless Brazil takes steps to protect the Amazon and the recent publication in Nature³ that has illustrated that the upward change in mean annual flood discharge per decade (%) in Ireland during the period 1960 – 2010 has been driven by increasing rainfall and soil moisture, I would urge An Bord Pleanála to comprehensively








Figure 1: SATELLITE IMAGERY OF SITE



Figure 1: DRAINAGE AND PEAT REMOVAL FROM NORTHERN SECTION OF BOG




Figure 2: DRAINAGE AND PEAT REMOVAL FROM SOUTHERN SECTION OF BOG



My name is Patrick Moran. I live at Sillogue, Kilberry, Navan, Co. Meath. On the 29th of July, 2019 I applied for a determination under S5 of the Planning and Development Acts 2000 – 2018 (KAS51942) as regards Drainage of wetland habitat (Raised Bog) and mechanical disturbance, extrusion of peat and removal of turf from a site at Drakerath, Wilkinstown, Co. Meath. On the 29th August I received a letter from Meath Co. Council informing me that Meath Co. Council had failed to deal with the application within the appropriate time frame and that should I wish I could refer the matter to An Bord Pleanála.

My application concerns an area of raised bog habitat (I am principal ecologist with FERS Ltd, an environmental consultancy) occurring at Drakerath, Wilkinstown, Co. Meath. Raised bog is a wetland habitat¹. Approximately 84% of Ireland's raised bog habitat has been affected by peat extraction, having implications for both climate and biodiversity². The site in question comprises approximately 88Ha (in total including areas of cutaway) wetland of high biodiversity value (and a regionally important carbon sink) that is being drained (the drain network discharges to the River Blackwater, a component of the River Boyne and River Blackwater Special Area of Conservation) and from which peat is being extracted by persons unknown. This development and similar developments nationwide are contributing to the climate and biodiversity emergency declared by the government. The development includes drainage of a wetland habitat (total area 88 ha approximately) where in excess of 2 ha of wetland habitat is being affected (cf 1 (c) part (2) schedule 5 of the planning and development regulations (as amended) 2001). This activity is having a significant impact on the environment. Even if considered sub-threshold, the impact on the environment of the development should require at minimum EIA screening in accordance with the planning and development regulations (as amended) 2001. 



Figure 1: SATELLITE IMAGERY OF SITE







Figure 1: DRAINAGE AND PEAT REMOVAL FROM NORTHERN SECTION OF BOG



HABITAT CONDITION ASSESSMENT FOR MARSH FRITILLARY

Habitat condition monitoring for the Marsh Fritillary involves fixed point habitat recording on a structured walk across a site, from which an assessment can be made. A separate survey and assessment should be completed for each sub-site.

METHOD

- Establish a W shape (zigzag) route that will cross thoroughly and evenly the whole site/sub-site.
- Decide stopping distances along this route where recordings of habitat condition will be made e.g. every 10 or 20 paces. Aim to have at least 20 stopping points for a small site (<1 ha) more than 40 stopping points for a medium-sized site (1-5 ha) and more than 50 stopping points for a large site (>5 ha).
- Follow your route and at each stopping point measure (in cm) the vegetation height at the point you stop (measure to the top of the leaves i.e. ignore the flowers of grasses and plants). Then, using an imaginary box with sides of 1 m in front of you, record the presence of Devil's-bit Scabious in one of these abundance categories (A = 1-2 plants, B = 3-9 plants, C = 10+ plants, D = No plants). Using the same area, record (mark with an 'X') the presence or absence of these three habitat attributes: structured vegetation, low (<25 cm tall) invading scrub with a cover of >10% and stock grazing signs (e.g. tracks, poach marks, dung).
- At the end of the assessment, then provide an estimate the cover (%) of tall (>0.5 m) scrub for the whole site/sub-site.




Figure 1: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:100,000




Figure 2: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:50,000




Figure 3: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:25,000




Figure 4: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:10,000

Figure 5: EVIDENCE OF POTENTIAL UNAUTHORISED ACTIVITY 07/06/21





Figure 6: EVIDENCE OF POTENTIAL UNAUTHORISED ACTIVITY 07/06/21

Figure 3: EVIDENCE OF POTENTIAL UNAUTHORISED ACTIVITY 09/05/20




Figure 4:EVIDENCE OF POTENTIAL UNAUTHORISED ACTIVITY 03/06/21




Figure 1: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:100,000





Figure 2: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:50,000




Figure 3: LOCATION OF ACTIVITY 1:25,000
